## **WORSHIP FOCUS**

Easter brings us joy because of the fact that Jesus has paid the penalty for our sins and won for us a new life in Jesus. Living in the post-resurrection age, what does it look like to live a life in Jesus? The Old Testament prophet Micah shares with us the vital signs of a follower of Jesus. He asks the rhetorical question: What does the Lord require of you? We will be diving into the answer that is given over the next three weeks: To act justly, love mercy and walk humbly with your God.
